Doc. Ing. Pavel Mertlík, CSc., Rector of the University, is a leading Czech economist and a long-time university lecturer. He graduated from the Faculty of Economics at the University of Economics, in the field of study Political Economics (Ing.), followed by the Candidate of Sciences degree (CSc.) in General Economics. In 1998, he became a docent of Economics at the Faculty of Social Sciences at Charles University.

He served as Deputy Prime Minister between 1998 and 2001 and as Minister of Finance from 1999. After retiring from politics, he worked for eleven years as the chief economist at Raiffeisenbank. He has published a number of expert articles, particularly in the field of price theory and analysis of transformation of central planned economies. In terms of his educational activities, he specialises in microeconomics, macroeconomics, institutional economics, economic policy and history of economic theories as well as public finance and financial markets. Pavel Mertlík has been the Rector of ŠKODA AUTO University since 2015.

Mgr. Petr Šulc has worked at the University since its foundation in 2000. He studied Geography and Mathematics at the Faculty of Natural Sciences of Charles University in Prague.

Between 1992 and 1996 Mr. Šulc taught at the Josef Pekař High School in Mladá Boleslav. He changed to ŠKODA AUTO College in 1996, where he worked as Deputy Director. He has been engaged in the establishment of ŠKODA AUTO University in 1999 – 2000. Then he worked as Vice-rector for Study Affairs at the University. After transformation of the ŠKODA AUTO University into a separate legal entity in 2013, he became its Rector. Mr. Šulc held his position until 2015. During this time, he played a significant role in all the transformation, accreditation and many development projects of the school. Currently he is Vice-Rector for Study Affairs and Head of Department of Informatics and Quantitative Methods. He is focused on teaching Mathematic and Statistics and he also provides advice in the field of Study Organizing. He cooperates in professional projects in field of Applied statistics.

Ing. David Holman, Ph.D. has 6 years (2007-2013) of practical experience in strategic planning of logistics and supply chain management in the automotive industry (ŠKODA AUTO). He finished his Ph.D. studies at the University of Economics in Prague with a successful final thesis: Cost estimation methodology of productivity LEAN utilized in supply chain in market conditions of 2nd decade of 21st century. He is an assistant professor and assistant of the head of Department of Logistics, Quality Management and Automobile Technology at ŠKODA AUTO University from 2013.

His pedagogical, research and consultant/lecturer activities are focused on Lean Logistics and Supply chain management. He is the guarantor, solver or co-solver of industrial company projects and educational, scientific and research projects supported by the University of Economics in Prague, ŠKODA AUTO University or EU funds.
