


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Project activities

During the last half a year the project team has carried out several important activities and achieved milestones planned within the project:

- | JEUL 1st Annual meeting took place at Banking University HCMC (Vietnam) on 18th-27th January and was combined with the seminar on results of enterprise survey & feedback from student placement (Task 3.2 of JEUL project), as well as support from EU experts to CN & VN in the implementation of VLE platform (Task 4.3 of JEUL project).
- | The report for Enterprise survey in China and Vietnam was prepared by project partners and is easily accessible via project website.
- | The follow up workshop on writing case studies took place take place in University of Kent (United Kingdom) from 13-17th May, 2019. During the workshop partners overviewed the progress of applying case studies in the study process in Chinese and Vietnamese universities.
- | First project students from Chinese and Vietnamese universities undertook placements in enterprises with great success and appreciation.

JEUL 1st Annual meeting



The first annual meeting which was hosted by Banking University HCMC (Vietnam) on 18th-27th January, 2019 was designed to evaluate the project progress and determine strong and weak points of the implementation in order to become even better in the future, as well as to prepare for the interim reporting, which was due in mid-April, 2019. Work package leaders shared the progress of WPs with other partners; ideas for further improvements were shared.

The project meeting also provided an opportunity for partners to discuss the results of enterprise survey carried out in China and Vietnam and feedback from students who undergone placement in companies.

Furthermore, EU experts were able to follow up on the trainings provided in Vilnius and Kent and provide additional assistance with the implementation of VLE platform for partner universities.

Follow up workshop on case studies

During the initial workshop in Vietnam in November, 2018 and during the time following the workshop, Chinese and Vietnamese partners carried out substantial work creating case studies and working towards increasing their use during lectures.

Thus, follow up workshop that took place in University of Kent in May, 2019 focused on overviewing the progress of incorporating the case studies in the learning processes, as well as sharing the ideas on lessons learned during the process.




Enterprise survey report

401 Chinese and Vietnamese enterprises took part in the survey to analyse the knowledge and skill gap of graduates in China and Vietnam. The survey was carried out for three months from September to December 2018. Such analysis provided deeper insights for JEUL partners on how curricula should be modernized and be more responsive to the labour market needs in Chinese and Vietnamese universities.

The report surveys have been distributed to the relevant target groups (universities, enterprises, research centres, chambers of commerce, decision makers at local, regional and national level, students) and discussed at the Seminar on results of enterprise survey (22-23 January 2019) in Ho Chi Min City.

To achieve the aim of bringing closer the students of Vietnamese and Chinese universities to entrepreneurial mind-set and closing the gap between the skills mismatch, universities had to establish a mechanism through which they can learn from enterprises by sending their staff and students to companies on placements and internships.
